# We all go with it.

- We don't wish to alarm you, but please, consider these facts:
1. Nairobi's 3 million residents have only one source of water: the Aberdare.
  2. In all, 9 million Kenyans' livelihoods are dependent upon the rainfall, rivers, forest and wildlife of the Aberdare.
  3. With the constant threat of illegal logging, the Aberdare could be all but barren within a decade - destroying the forests, delicate eco-system and depriving five major rivers of water.
- Alarming facts indeed, though, there is a simple solution. That is, to fence in the Aberdare completely, keeping the illegal loggers out and the wildlife in.
- 160 kilometers of electrified fence has already been built, now we're asking for your help to build the remaining 150 kms.
